Mission and Vision

We are a community center that serves the needs of the people of downtown Meridian and the whole Treasure Valley through the compassion and love of Jesus.

We provide community for those in need, and we live real life together with others. We offer Health Education, Life Management, Advocate Support, Coaching, Family Support, Long-term Growth Programs, Mental Wellness, Prayer and Encouragement.

We work with anyone who is lonely, hopeless and don't have a support system or safety net, because we believe every person has the potential to change their own lives and the lives of those around them.

Impact and Numbers 23-24

- 6 people in Jumpstart program have received coaching and support.
- 200+ people served through hotline, referral program, legal clinic and walk-ins.
- 10 organizations (nonprofit, government, etc) using the building.
- 100+ people prayed for, given the gospel message and encouraged.
- 43 kids attended our kids camp Summer 2023.

- Jumpstart Program Development: \$39,795
- Referral, Support, Health Programs: 25,000
- Mental Wellness Program: \$14,200
